International collaboration includes large scale field level activities in Vietnam and Mozambique funded from a variety of bilateral and multilateral sources. Duties involve frequent travel to these two and many other developing countries. Other duties have included being a member of the International and the Research Committees at the Department of Economics and supervisor of a very large number of Ph.D. and M.Sc. students.
